## Guidelines for Happy Camping

*Our goal at Oak Park Kampground is to maintain a family friendly atmosphere and provide a safe, fun and memorable camping experience for our guests.*

- Check in Time: 1:00 pm
- Check out Time: 12:00 pm (Early arrival or late check-out may be available.)
- All guests and visitors must register & pay at the office before entering the Park. Visitors must leave the park by 9pm
- QUIET HOURS: 11 pm to 7 am. *Strictly Enforced!*
- Alcoholic beverages are allowed at your site or in a container such that it is not displayed in the campground. Absolutely No non-prescription drugs allowed on property.
- Please refrain from using profanity while in the park
- Please do not bring Firearms, bows and arrows, slingshots or fireworks of any type, as they are not permitted on park grounds
- Please leave your Motor Bikes/ATV's and Golf Carts at home unless otherwise approved by management.
- Campground friendly pets are allowed, however please be sure to read our People Owner Courtesies.
- Parents are responsible for the safety and behavior of their children in the park.
- Pool: NO LIFE GUARD ON DUTY SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK. Children must be accompanied and supervised by an adult (someone 18 or over) at all times at the pool. More guidelines posted at the pool must be read and followed.

## Firewood Restrictions (<http://www.dnr.state.mn.us/firewood/why.html>)

### *Why Firewood Restrictions?*

Emerald ash borer (EAB) and many other **forest pests and diseases** can be accidentally transported in firewood. In order to help prevent the introduction and spread of invasive pests, state statute was amended by **commissioner's order** in March 2011 banning all firewood in state-owned camping facilities unless approved by the DNR (Minnesota Statute, section 89.551, Sec. 2).

### *Approved Firewood is:*

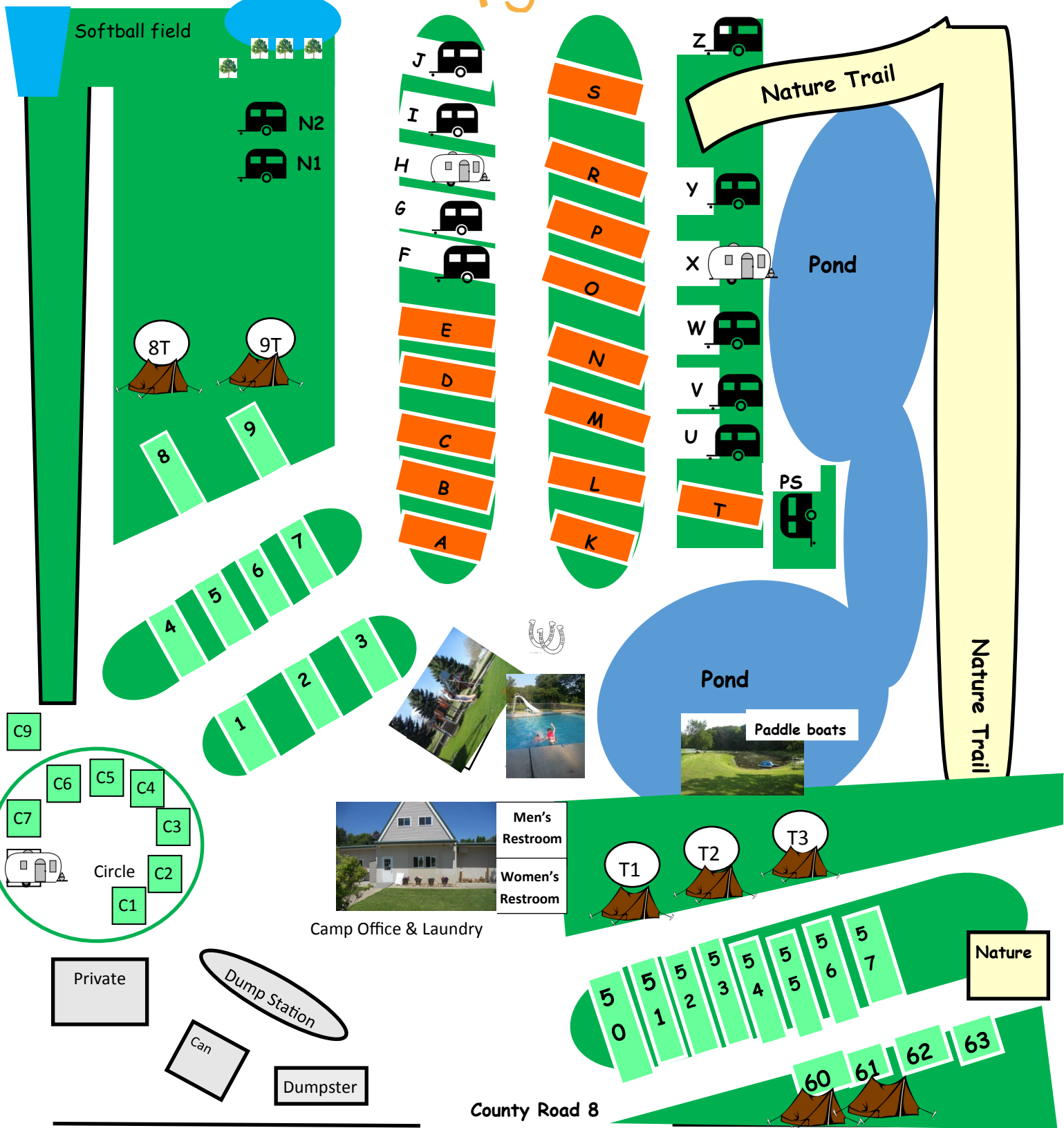
- wood harvested in Minnesota not more than 50 miles from the state-administered lands where it will be burned
- kiln-dried, unpainted, unstained dimensional lumber
