

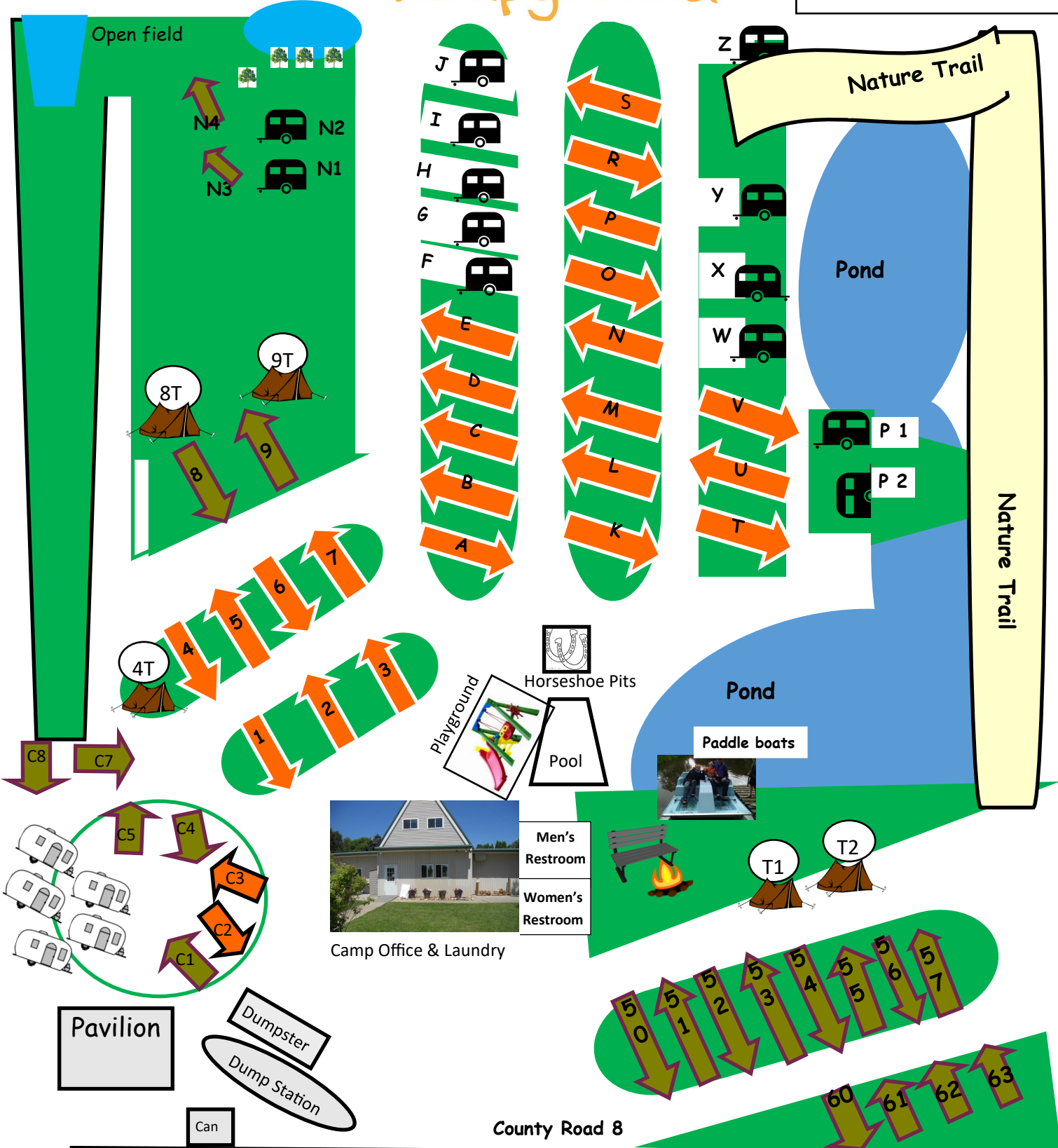

Welcome to Oak Park Kampground Please review our Guidelines for Happy Camping!

These guidelines have been established for your safety and to allow you and your fellow campers to enjoy a memorable stay at Oak Park

CHECK IN TIME: You may check in anytime after 1 pm and before 10pm.

CHECK OUT TIME: 12:00 pm Early arrival or late check out may be arranged with the office if site is available.

GUESTS: State law requires that all guests and visitors register at the office before entering the Park. **Visitor hours** are from **9am until 9:30 pm**. We reserve the right to refuse entrance to any and all visitors. **Visitor fee of \$3 or \$5 on holiday weekends is charged. Limit of 4 guests per site, in COVID times and they must use your bathroom.**

VEHICLES: Please park camper and all vehicles on the gravel pad, not on the grass. **Only 1 vehicles allowed per site.** Extra vehicles must be park in overflow parking.

RESTROOMS: In the times of COVID-19 they are Only available for those folks camping in a tent or pop up. Closed for cleaning daily, as posted, porta potty is available.

QUIET HOURS: 10 pm to 7 am Please respect the tranquility of neighboring campers, **all outdoor lights, radios & TVs must be turned off during quiet hours** and **voices should be at a whisper.** Taste in music varies considerably, please keep the volume of radios, TVs etc. maintained such that it is not heard beyond your site at all times. Playground is closed at 9:30 pm until 7 am. Children under 18 must return to their campsite by 9:30 pm.

ALCOHOL/DRUGS: Adults are welcome to consume alcoholic beverages, **(in moderation please!), on their campsite only.** Absolutely No non-prescription drugs allowed on property. Abuse of alcohol or drugs will be cause for immediate eviction without refund..

PROFANITY: Please refrain from using profanity while in the park.

FIREARMS/FIREWORKS: The use of firearms, bows and arrows, slingshots or fireworks of any type are not allowed on park grounds.

SPEED LIMIT & ROADS: 5mph will be enforced for the safety of all campers.. Please leave your Motor Bikes/ATV's and Golf Carts at home unless otherwise approved by management.

WASHING/MAINTENANCE: of Vehicles or Trailers is not permitted.

BACKFLOW PREVENTION: Is required by the MN Health Department, they are available for loan at the camp store.

CLOTHESLINES/HAMMOKS/DOG TIES: We ask that you **tie nothing to our trees.** Therefor these items are only allowed if not tied to our trees and clothes lines must be taken down at night.

FIREWOOD: No outside Firewood allowed unless MN certified. Most people choose our campground due to our beautiful trees, this is to protect them. Convetion

OUTSIDE MATS/RUGS/KIDDIE POOLS/SCREENROOMS W/ FLOORS: No outside mats, kiddie pools, screenrooms please, as they kill the grass.

CAMPFIRES: Please use the fires rings provided, where they are on the site. All fires must be **completely** extinguished before you retire for the evening or leave the campsite. Please do not cut or damage any trees or vegetation within the park. Please do not put trash in fire pits.

PETS: Campground friendly pets are allowed, however we do restrict those breeds perceived to be dangerous. Please be sure to read and abide by our People Owner Courtesies. All owners must be able to provide proof of current vaccinations including rabies if required. **Pets must be on 6' or less hand held leash at all times. Do not tie dogs to trees.**

SUPERVISION: Parents are responsible tor the safety and behavior of their children. Young children should be supervised by an adult at all times in the park.

BICYCLES: For your safety **we do not allow bike riding after sunset** in the campground. Bicycles must obey 5mph speed limit. Please ride only on roads or trails. Due to gravel roads we do not allow skateboards or scooters.

DRONES: Please leave them at home, as they may not be used in the park..

PADDLE BOATS: Paddle boats can be signed out by an adult in the office, all riders must wear life jackets and children must be 10 yrs. or older to be on the boat without an adult. Boats can be checked out between the hours of 8:30 am and sunset.

POOL: NO LIFE GUARD ON DUTY SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK. Food or drink are allowed on the pool deck but not in the pool. **NO GLASS CONTAINERS.** No one can be in the pool alone. Children who are accomplished swimmers over the age of 14 may enter the pool, all other children **MUST** be accompanied and supervised by an adult (someone 18 or over) at all times. at the pool. Additional **POOL RULES** are posted at the pool and must be read and observed.

We are not responsible for accidents or injury to our guests and/or damage of personal belongings while camping at our Campground.
